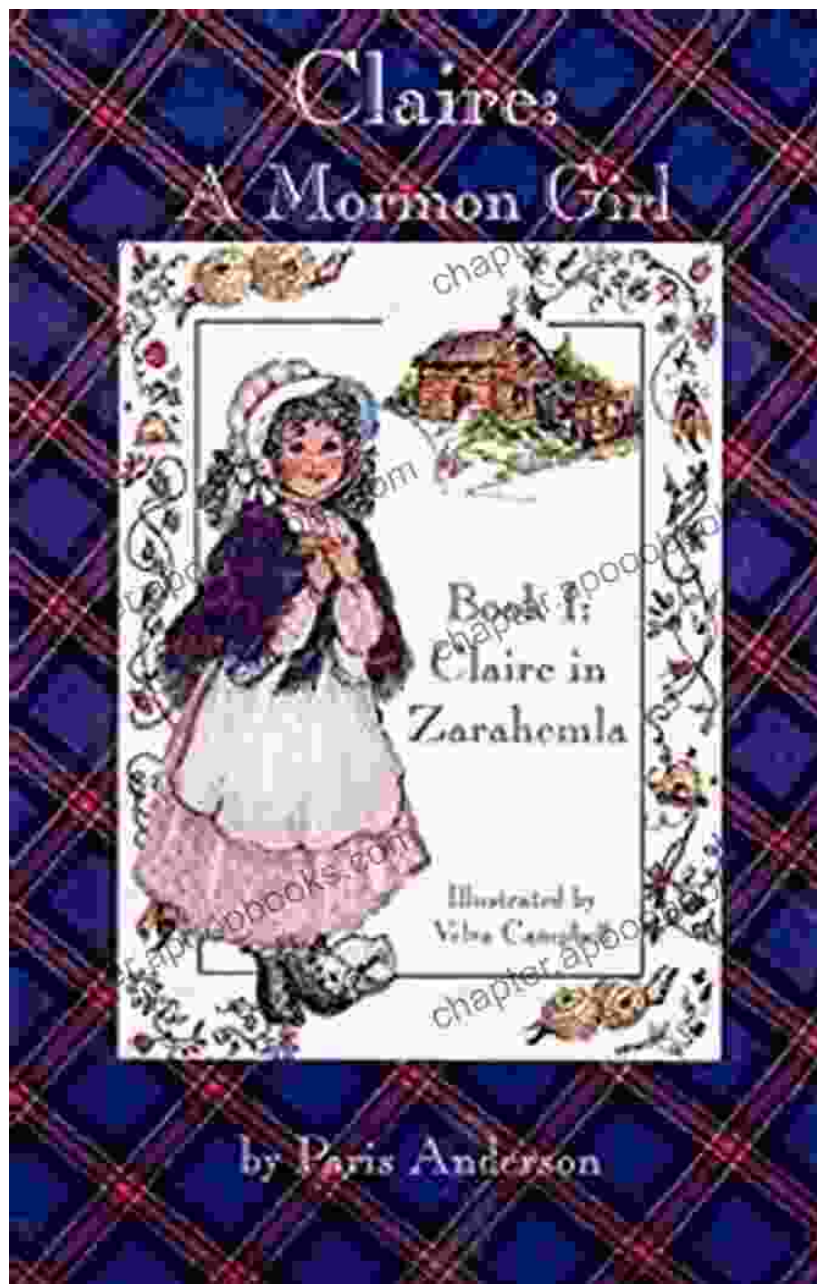


Claire: A Mormon Girl in Zarahemla

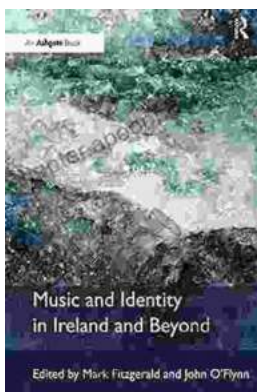
